



City of Emporia Mosquito Control Program

The goal of the City of Emporia Mosquito Control Program is to protect public health by reducing the number of mosquitoes during the season from May 1st through October. This program includes fogging/spraying areas within the City from public street starting after 5:00pm.

- Our schedule consists of one application per week city wide.
- Date of application varies due to weather conditions.

Helpful Tips to control mosquito population

- Get rid of water in containers.
- Repair leaky water faucets, water hose and air conditioners.
- Screen or cover rain barrels, garbage cans and other large containers.
- Keep grass cut short and well-trimmed around the house so adult mosquitoes would not have a place to hide.
- Please refrain from blowing grass into the streets that will clog storm drains.
- Clean leaf filled gutters to allow proper drainage.
- Turn buckets, baby pools and other outside containers upside down when not in use.

The City of Emporia Mosquito Control Program works to reduce mosquito population throughout the city.

There is no scientific evidence that mosquitos transmit the coronavirus but wearing face mask and washing hands regularly is recommended.
